

Testing Instructions

- Yazaki North America (YNA) uses the following EDI mailbox information:

- For each prospective EDI capable vendor we will test as follows:
 - 830
 - YNA will generate and transmit a test 830 for each vendor. This 830 will be flagged as a test document. (i.e. There will be a "T" in element ISA15.)
 - The vendor will retrieve the test 830 and process it into their system as a test document.
 - The vendor's EDI system is expected to automatically return a 997 in response to the receipt of the 830.
 - The vendor will generate a report of their choice, or take screen prints, that show the release has been processed into their system. This report should be delivered to the Yazaki EDI Team for evaluation.

 - The Yazaki EDI Team will review the vendor's report and, if necessary, will verify with the vendor that the test 830 was received and processed normally.
 - If any errors are found in the vendor's 830 report, the vendor's EDI contact will be notified via e-mail. The vendor then has 24 hours to correct and retransmit the 830 report.
 - 856
 - Once the receipt and processing of the test 830 is complete, verified, and approved, the vendor will use the received information to generate and transmit a test 856 back to YNA. This test 856 must use the same information as was sent on the test 830.
 - YNA will retrieve the test 856 from our VAN's mailbox (see above).
 - YNA's EDI system will automatically send a 997 back to the vendor in response to the receipt of the test 856.
 - We will then verify that the information received on the test 856 is acceptable and will process into our system correctly. The vendor will be notified via e-mail of any errors that exist. The vendor then has 24 hours to correct and retransmit the 856.
 - Once the vendor has submitted an error-free 856 they will have completed their EDI testing.
 - NOTE: Even though the vendor has completed their EDI Testing successfully, they will not be considered fully EDI Compliant until they are able to submit three consecutive error-free production 856s.

NOTE: Those suppliers that use a third party EDI translation software package that has been certified as EDI Compliant by YNA may be eligible to have their EDI Testing waived. Suppliers to YNA should contact their EDI software supplier to inquire about their software's certification status.
