Detailed Instructions for Completing the USMCA Certificate of Origin

For purposes of obtaining preferential tariff treatment, this document must be completed legibly and in full by the exporter and be in the possession of the importer at the time the declaration is made. This document may also be completed voluntarily by the producer for use by the exporter. Please print or type:

Verify that pre-filled fields 1 through 5 on the Certificate of Origin header page are correct.

Field 1 Certifier: Select the Importer, Exporter or Producer. Make sure this one is selected.

Certifier Name, Address including Country, Telephone number, e-mail address.

The legal tax identification number will need to be completed as follows: in Canada, employer number or importer/exporter number assigned by Canada Revenue Agency; in Mexico, federal taxpayer's registry number (RFC); and in the United States, employer's identification number or Social Security number.

Field 2 Blanket Period: This pre-filled information indicates the blanket period during which the information for the goods described on the attachment pages will be considered valid for purposes of import and export.

Field 3 Exporter: This information could be pre-filled with the statement "Various". If the producer and the exporter are the same, please indicate this by indicating "SAME" in this field. Please also feel free to complete the full legal producer

Field 4 Producer: This information could pre-filled with the statement "Available to Customs upon request". If the producer and the exporter are the same, please indicate this by indicating "SAME" in this field. Please also feel free to complete the full

Field 5 Importer: This information could pre-filled with the statement "VARIOUS". If this is unacceptable according to company practices, the field may be revised to state "Various Yazaki locations."

Field 6 Description of Goods: This information is pre-filled according to our system data. If it is incorrect, or if a supplier part number is not listed with the YNA part number, please add this information.

YAZAKI NORTH AMERICA, INC. (YNA) NOTE:

*Please add any additional parts supplied to YNA that are not listed on the document.

Field 7 HS Tariff Classification: For each good described in field 5, the corresponding H.S. tariff classification to six digits is listed.

If you disagree with the part classification, cross out the YNA HTS number provided. Write the number you believe to be correct below YNA assigned HTS number and apply the rule of origin. Please also state the reason for such classification

Field 8 Origin Criterion: For each good described in field 6, state which criterion (A through D) is applicable. The rules of origin are contained in Chapter Four, Annex 4-B

NOTE: In order to be entitled for preferential treatment, each good must meet at least one of the criteria below.

Description of Preference Criteria

A. Wholly obtained or produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties, as defined in Article 4.3 (Wholly Obtained or Produced Goods);

B. Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties using non-originating materials provided the good satisfies all applicable requirements of Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin);

C. Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties exclusively from originating materials; or

D. except for a good provided for in Chapter 61 to 63 of the Harmonized System:

1. Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties;
2. One or more of the non-originating materials provided for as parts under the Harmonized System used in the production of the good cannot satisfy the requirements set out in Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin) because both the good and
3. The regional value content of the good, determined in accordance with Article 4.5 (Regional Value Content), is not less than 60 percent if the transaction value method is used, or not less than 50 percent if the net cost method is used; and

and the good satisfies all other applicable requirements of this Chapter.

NOTE 1: This criterion does not apply to goods that wholly originate in Canada or the United States and are imported into either country.

Field 9 Country of Origin: Identify the name of the country ("MX", "US" or "CA")

YAZAKI NORTH AMERICA (YNA) NOTE:

If the part is deemed "NOT ELIGIBLE" the country of origin must be provided.

Field 10 Certification Statement and signature: This field must be completed, signed and dated by the exporter. When the Certificate is completed by the producer for use by the exporter, it must be completed, signed, and dated by the producer. The
